CLAT 2027: Why It Is Now Important for Students Seeking Admission to Lucknow University's 5-Year Integrated Law Program

For students in Lucknow and across Uttar Pradesh who are planning to pursue a 5-year integrated law degree, the admission landscape has changed significantly. The University of Lucknow has introduced CLAT scores as an important route for admission to its LL.B. (Integrated Five Years) programme. For the 2026–27 admission cycle, the University's official brochure states that admission to the programme would be based on CLAT 2026 scores, with the University Entrance Test (UGET) being used for seats that remain vacant.

This development makes CLAT preparation relevant not only for students targeting National Law Universities (NLUs), but also for students whose primary goal is to study law at Lucknow University.

What Has Changed for Lucknow University Law Admissions?

According to the University of Lucknow's 2026–27 admission brochure, the LL.B. (Integrated Five Years) programme has 330 seats, apart from 30 NRI/NRI-sponsored seats.

For the CLAT-based route, the University specified:

General category: minimum 60 marks out of 120 in CLAT 2026.

OBC/SC/ST/PwBD categories: minimum 54 marks out of 120.

Eligible candidates could seek admission based on their CLAT merit and were not required to appear for the University Entrance Examination.

Remaining vacant seats could subsequently be filled through the University's UGET.

The University has also published separate admission and seat-allotment notices relating to CLAT-based admission for the integrated five-year law programme.

This means CLAT is no longer relevant only to students dreaming of an NLU. It can also become an important admission pathway for students specifically targeting Lucknow University.

Important: The exact eligibility criteria, CLAT score requirement and admission procedure for 2027–28 will depend on the official University notification for that admission cycle. Students should therefore treat the 2026 criteria as the current precedent, not as a guaranteed 2027 cutoff.

Why Should Lucknow University Aspirants Take CLAT 2027 Seriously?

Traditionally, a student wanting to study law at Lucknow University could focus primarily on the University's own admission process.

The introduction of CLAT-based admission changes that strategy.

CLAT requires students to apply information rather than simply memorise it.

Practise passage-based questions regularly and analyse every mistake.

4. Don't Ignore Quantitative Techniques

Even students primarily targeting Lucknow University should prepare the complete CLAT syllabus because the 2027 admission requirements may differ from the current cycle.

5. Take Mock Tests
